SUBJECT: Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Army ROTC Leadership Conference

1. The Army ROTC Rattler Battalion will be holding our 7th annual Leadership Conference from 31 March 2022 to 02 April 2022. Our goal is to enhance the leadership capabilities of future Army officers and create ties between past leaders and future commanders.
